He graduated from Conotton Valley High School in 1960, then earned a bachelor's degree from Moravian University in Bethlehem, PA. John later earned his master's degree in education from Kent State University. He was an educator throughout his life in all he did. He started his career in education as a teacher for Dover, Conotton Valley, and Claymont schools and then became an elementary school principal at Claymont, where he retired after more than thirty years. Following that, he began working for WTUZ radio station, where he became the chief engineer.

He was also an active member in various clubs and groups. John was in the Tusco Amateur Radio club for more than 60 years, working with and teaching others through a tech forum and club activities. He was a long time member of QCWA 21 – Canton Chapter. He was a member of the Free & Accepted Masons, raised with the Orange Lodge #406, where he also served as Past Master, was a member of the Mystic Tie Lodge #194, was a member of Port Washington Lodge #202, was a York Rite Mason, a Scottish Rite Mason of the 32nd degree, and a Shriner. John was also a member of the Gnadenhutten United Methodist Church and participated in Journey through Faith. He was also very involved with the Boy Scouts of America, from which he received the Silver Beaver Award. In his spare time, John loved to garden and hike in the woods.
